<b>feudalism</b>	political and social order that developed during the Middle Ages when royal governments were no longer able to defend their subjects
<b>vassal</b>	under feudalism, a man who served a lord in a military capacity
<b>knight</b>	under feudalism, a member of the heavily armored cavalry

<b>feudal contract</b>	under feudalism, the unwritten rules that determined the relationship between a lord and his vassal
<b>chivalry</b>	in the Middle Ages, the ideal of civilized behavior that developed among the nobility
