1. Clan	a group of related families
2. Longhouse	Iroquois house about 150 to 200 feet long built of wooden poles covered with sheets of bark and housing about a dozen families
3. Maize	corn
4. Quipu	a system of knotted strings used by the Inca people for keeping records
5. <b>Tepee</b>	a circular tent made by stretching buffalo skins over wooden poles
