<b>salt flat</b>	<b>flat land made of chemical salts that remain after winds evaporate the moisture in the soil.</b>

<b>desalinization</b>	<b>the removal of salt from ocean water</b>
<b>fossil water</b>	<b>water pumped from underground aquifers</b>
<b>crude oil</b>	<b>petroleum that has not been processed</b>
<b>refinery</b>	<b>a place where crude oil is converted into useful products.</b>
