So...I debated even posting because I'm having a perfectly lovely, productive Monday. LOL!!

But - with schools starting back face-to-face the panic has started with the "oh my gosh a staff member/student has tested positive!!!"

I've said it before, and this is SUPER important when it causes panic and forced quarantines. We will never be able to have school if they simply go by "positive" tests.

The test is not binary. Unlike a pregnancy test, it's not a yes or no kind of a test. That's not how it works, and it was never intended to be used as a diagnostic test - as per the inventor.

Your body carries viruses all the time and the test detects pieces of those viruses. Depending on which lab processes it and what ranges they have set - you could get different results from different labs as far as if you are "positive" or "negative". And they aren't sending the data for how many cycles they are using, so you have no idea if you are even considered to be contagious.

"In three sets of testing data that include cycle thresholds, compiled by officials in Massachusetts, New York and Nevada, up to 90% of people testing positive carried barely any virus, a review by The New York Times found."

"Tests with thresholds so high may detect not just live virus but also genetic fragments, leftovers from infection that pose no particular risk — akin to finding a hair in a room long after a person has left, Mina said.

So "positive" doesn't mean you are contagious. It doesn't mean you will ever develop symptoms.
