"We don't plan to hit the pause button," said Fred Sordahl, President of the PPS school board, as he spoke about hiring Dr. Lisa Muller as Pryor's new Superintendent. "Dr. Muller has the exact qualities of what we need to take us to the next level. As a board, we are glad she is here."



Muller, who has worked in education for 30 years most recently served as the Associate Superintendent of Educational Services at Jenks Public Schools. She has held that title since 2017 and has a diverse history of teaching and leading in many areas of the education sector.

Dr. Muller began her career as a high school English and History teacher at Alief Independent School District located in southwest Houston. She and her family moved to Oklahoma in 1997 where she taught History at Jenks High School. In 2000 she became the Principal of Jenks High School serving in that role for 7 years before becoming an assistant superintendent. Over the past 14 years as an assistant superintendent, she has provided direction and oversight for the district elementary and secondary schools, curriculum and instruction, student assessment, professional development, and student services. Muller was also a key player in the opening of a new elementary school, the first new school built within the Jenks district in 25 years. She also established the AVID program in Jenks. AVID stands for Advancement Via Individual Determination and is a nonprofit college-readiness program designed to help students develop the skills they need to be successful in college.




Although Muller admitted that she was not actively looking to leave Jenks, she was impressed with the opportunities afforded to all students at Pryor Public Schools. She went on to applaud the district-wide implementation of character education, the Leader in Me program, and the pathways created for each individual student. Muller also added that the strong leadership of Dr. Raleigh has left Pryor in an "excellent position."

As Dr. Muller steps into her new role of superintendent, Dr. Raleigh expressed, "I hope

she will be received with the same warm welcome that I received thirteen years ago from our students, staff, and community. She will be a great leader in this district, and I am excited to see where the district goes under her leadership."

Dr. Muller and her husband plan on moving to Pryor and look forward to becoming part of the community.





























































































