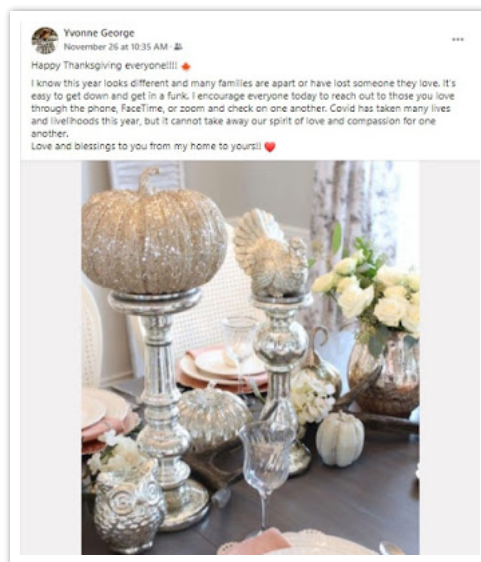


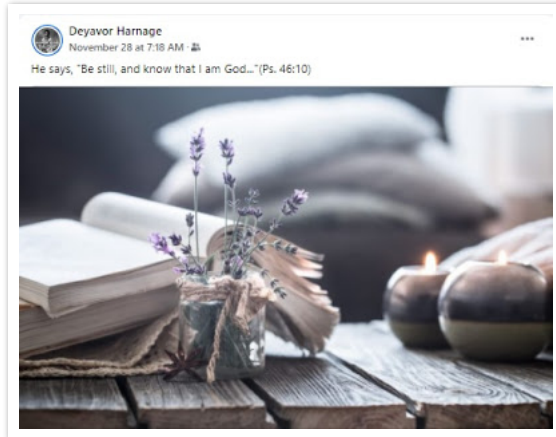
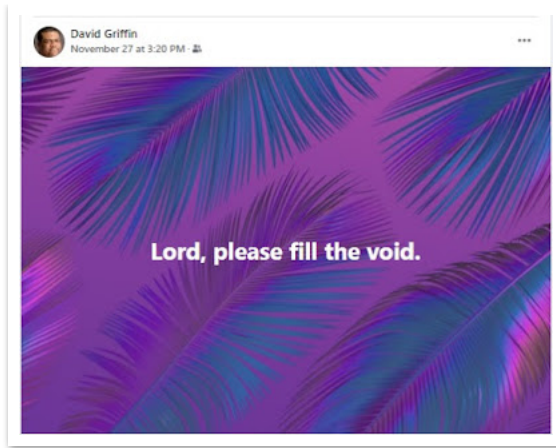














Danza Reavis Faucett is in Richland Park, Richmond, Texas.

For the last three months I was committed to an Alzheimer's/Dementia study. It was to be a 4 year study that I was willing to complete if they felt I was a good candidate. I was not allowed to speak about it on social media and went through rigorous testing to see if I was a good candidate for the study. I have a lot of what they were looking for, mainly the fact that my father died a few years back and had Alzheimer's for about 8 years. Remember...it's not the disease that kills you...it is the problems with the decline of the brain that affect other important functions of your body that cause the decline and eventually your mortality.

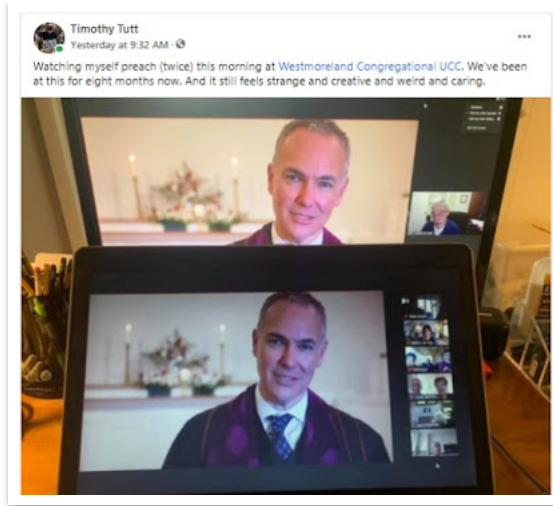
I had to have a study partner (Rodney) that needed to monitor me closely. We both had to come to the clinic where we were in separate rooms for hours of tests and questioning to see if I had decline in memory for one month to the next. I had many blood tests, an MRI and the most interesting, a PET scan.

Long story to short I was given good news and some not so good news. My PET scan showed negative for amyloid on the brain. Yes! That was the good news. Unfortunately though, I am a carrier and positive for the APOE4 genetic marker. There is a possibility I could get Alzheimer's and there is a possibility that I could not. We do not know nor can we predict this. There still is not enough known about this illness which is why I felt the need to be a part of this important study. They had already accepted their 30% of people with my type of outcome so they told me they would keep my info on file for future studies.

I am sharing this with you because I think that it is important that if you have the opportunity or time to become part of a study you could be the one person that helps to bring forth some breaking new procedures or medicines to abolish this awful disease that affects so many of our loved ones.
